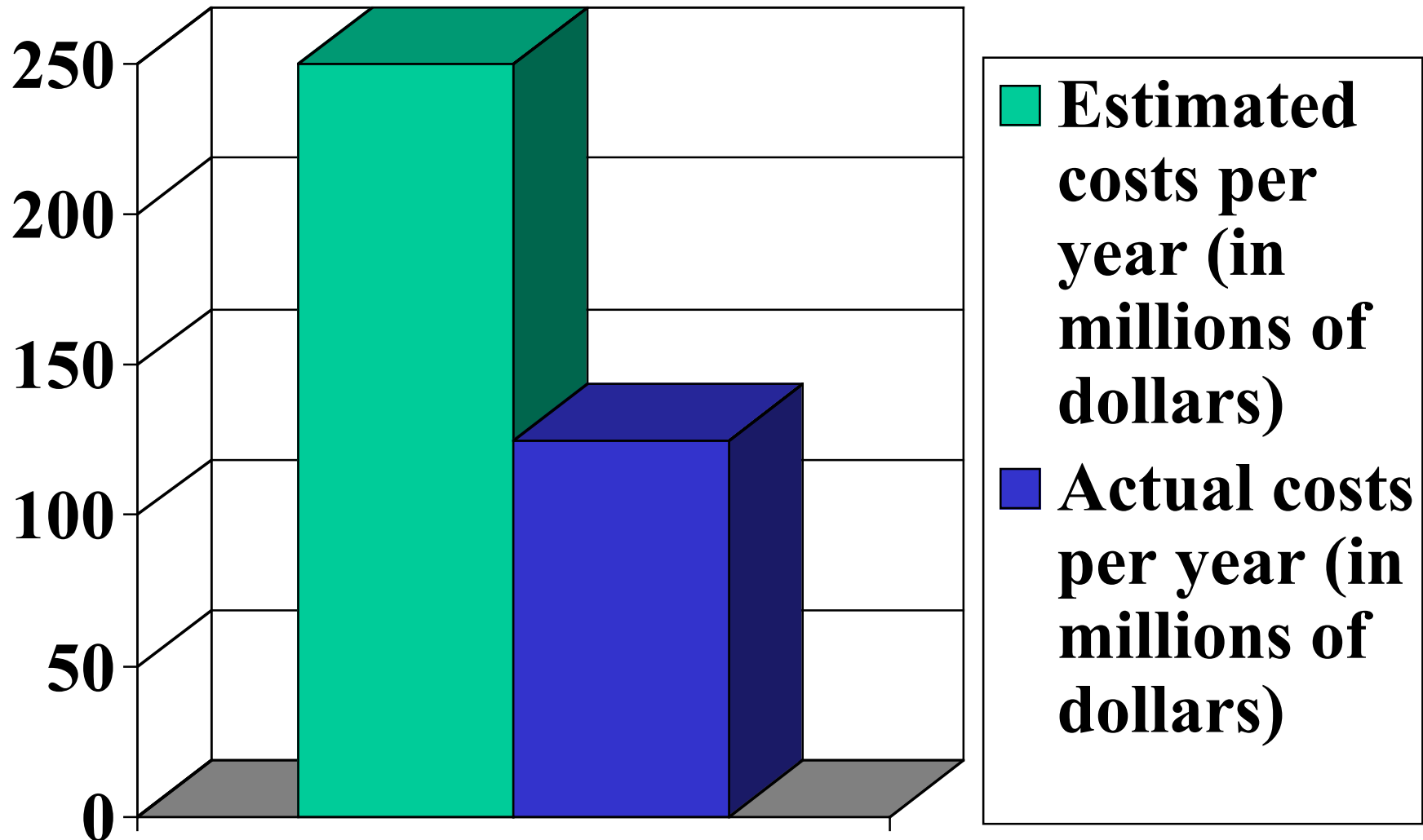
What do opponents say?

- It's too expensive
- Genetic supermarkets
- Genetic discrimination
- Psychological unrest

It's too expensive

- Used only half the expected budget
- Smallest institute of NIH, which itself has an inexpensive budget
- Completed earlier than predicted

10 year budget



Genetic supermarkets

- Proposition is “bunk” and “totally without scientific foundation”
- Impossible to engineer traits because too many genes make up each characteristic
